## STAR STUDENTS!

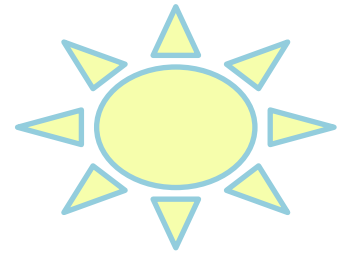

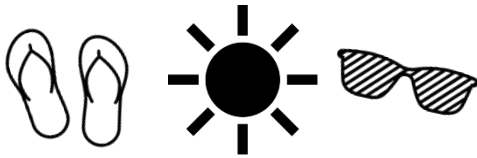

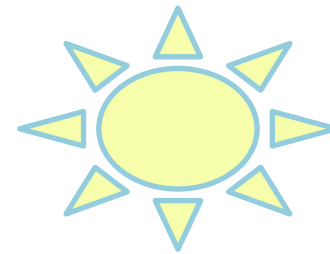
## INFANT STAR OF THE MONTH!

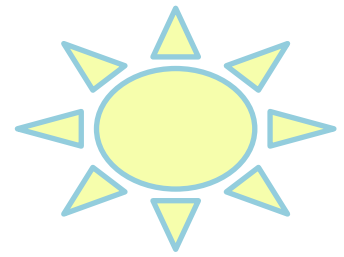

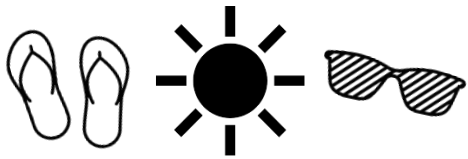

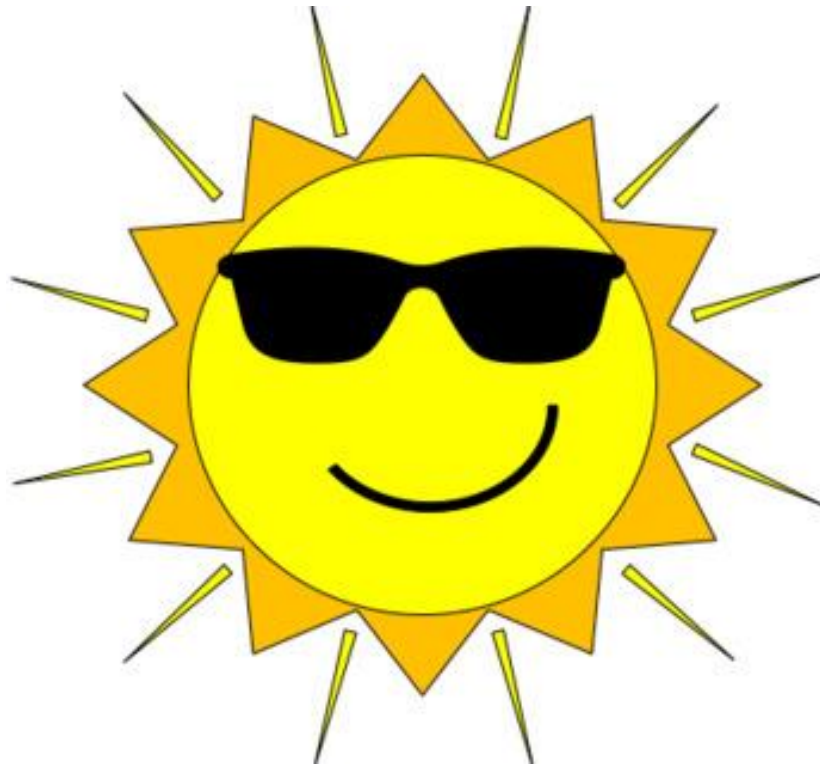

## PRE-K 3 STAR OF THE MONTH!



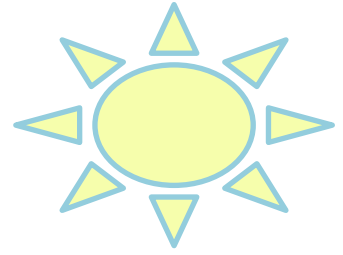

Calvin! Keep up the great work! We love you!!!

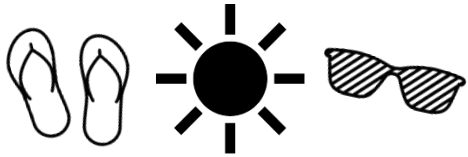
