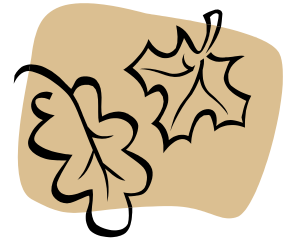
Infant Star Of The Month!

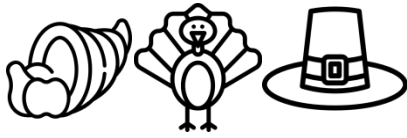

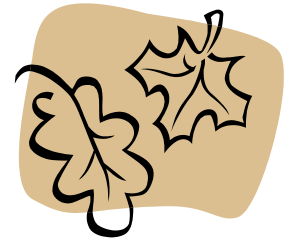
Toddler Star Of The Month!

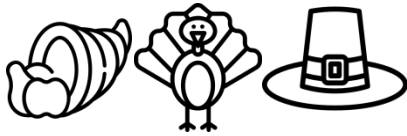
PRE-K 3 NEWS

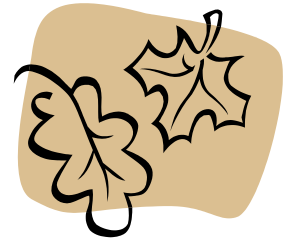
Cameron!!

Pre-K 3 Star Of The Month!



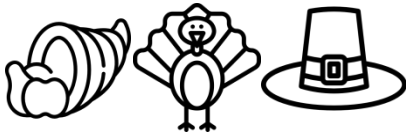
