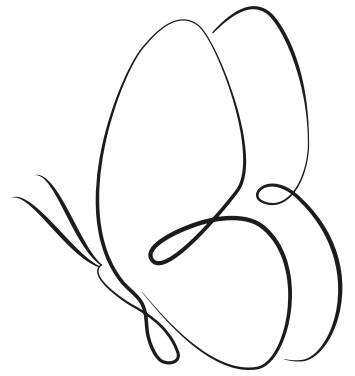
TODDLER ROOM STAR STUDENT

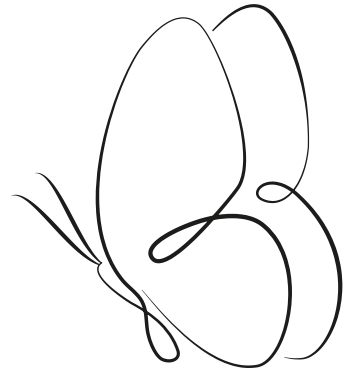

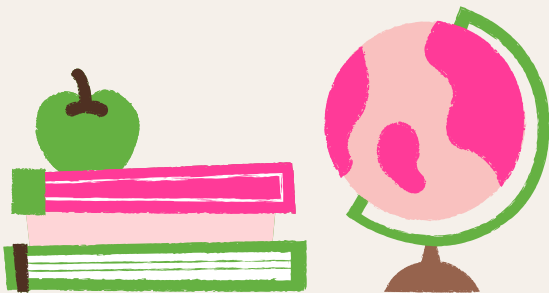
